

Intimate Care and Home School Agreement

Downside Preschool understands that not all children develop at the same rate, therefore we will ensure children that are not toilet trained are given equal opportunities.

We ask the parent to:

- Agree to ensure that the child is changed at the latest possible time before coming to preschool.
- Provide the preschool with spare nappies, clothes, wipes and any prescribed creams (The medicine form will also need to be signed) and nappy sacks.
- All nappy changing equipment should be placed in a named bag (names on outside of bag).
- Understand and agree to procedures that will be followed when your child is changed at preschool.
- Agree to inform the preschool should the child have any rashes/marks.
- Agree to review arrangements should this be necessary.
- Agree to a toileting program that fits with curriculum activity to promote continence.
- Talk to the preschool manager if you have any concerns

The Pre School will:

- Change your child should they become soiled or uncomfortably wet during the session.
- Children that attend all day will be given a care plan ensuring that they are changed at regular intervals throughout the day.
- Monitor your child to identify progress made.
- Report to you should the child be distressed, or if marks/rashes are seen. If child protection issues arise the preschools child protection procedures will be followed.
- We will agree to review arrangements should this be necessary.
- We agree to a toilet training program that fits with curriculum activity to promote continence.

The Children will:

- Feel comfortable with whoever is changing them.
- Can choose which member of staff they would like to change them.
- Changing will take place in the toilets.
- The child should be changed standing up where possible.
- The child will be encouraged to be independent with their self-care by being supported to get undressed and dressed themselves.
